The Job – Full Stack Developer

The majority of your time is spent on Scrum based, C# development working on greenfield projects. WMDA is currently transitioning towards a cloud native environment focused primarily on the Microsoft stack with Azure and Azure DevOps as our primary toolset. A knowledge of Azure isn't a requirement but a willingness to learn and dive into this is. You participate in international projects from scoping, requirements gathering through implementation and standardisation. We trust you to make decisions that help our growing organisation move forward, solve problems, take initiatives and we will give you a lot of freedom to do so in a small but skilled development team.

Working in our team

We work in a small company (< 10 full time employees) but work with organisations all around the world. We establish best practices for all of our community and we will give you the opportunity to help improve and add to these standards from a technical perspective. You will be challenged and entrusted with a high level of responsibility in our informal organisation. Our development team is new, but very skilled and working very hard on the professionalisation of our team.

- Have an excellent command of the English language and preferably one or more other languages.
- Have a European work permit are willing to commute to Leiden.
